Almost all the participants after short introduction sang the mantra of Avaloketeswara: OM MANI PADME HUM. There were others who only introduced themselves but excused from singing. Then, Dr. Aditi invited her accompanist, Mr. Rahul Sharma (Pakhawaj) and Ms. ILA Sharma (tanpura) to take seat on the stage to present a brief recital of Dhrupad. Everyone enjoyed the music.

At the end, Lama Doboom Tulku thanked everyone for participating in the workshop. He said he wanted to keep the audience small and people came in a manageable number of 45. He offered white scarfs and honorarium to the artists and also thanked Ms. Kumud Gaba for doing a wonderful comparing. He then invited everyone for a simple vegetarian lunch at the IIC Annex Court.
